

**Answer Key to
“Biblical Heroes of the Faith: Studies in Hebrews 11”**

FAITH is belief or trust.

FAITH is not unbelief or distrust.

Session #1:

By faith I can please God and I can offer spiritual sacrifices.

Session #2:

Enoch walked with God.

Enoch pleased God.

By faith I can know God’s will and I can do His good pleasure (or, please Him).

Session #3:

Noah pleased God. (or, Noah walked with God.)

Noah obeyed God.

By faith I can receive God’s Word and I can obey God’s Word (or, do what it says).

Session #4:

God promised Abraham a land
a nation
a name
a blessing
and a son. (or, heir).

“By faith” Abraham went to → an unknown place.

“By faith” Abraham sojourned in → a foreign land.

God has promised me eternal life (1 John 2:25),
the crown of life (James 1:12),
the kingdom (James 2:5),
long life (Ephesians 6:2-3).

Session #5:

God gave her strength to conceive a child (Hebrews 11:11).

Sarah decided God was faithful (11:11), therefore, God gave many descendants to Abraham.

Strength when I am afraid (Psalm 27:1).
Strength when I am in trouble (Psalm 46:1).
Strength when I work (Proverbs 31:17).
Such strength is not found in wealth (or, money) (Psalm 52:7).

Session #6:

The city of the living God (Hebrews 12:22).
We are seeking a future city (13:14).
Our citizenship is in heaven (Philippians 3:20).
